

Attention Parents:

Reevaluations for exceptional student education (ESE) students must occur every 3 years. Orange County Public Schools (OCPS) is currently reviewing all ESE student records to determine the reevaluation status for each child served through an ESE program. Reevaluations deemed out of date or overdue will be processed for immediate correction.

No action is required on the parent's part at this time. A staff member from your child's school will notify you to request consent for the completion of a reevaluation of your child's ESE program as appropriate.
