COVE Meeting Minutes

The Construction Oversight and Value Engineering Committee (COVE) monthly meeting convened on Thursday January 22, 2015 at 8:12 a.m., at Facilities Services, 6501 Magic Way, Bldg. 200, and Orlando, Florida 32809.

COVE Members in Attendance: Ksenia Merck, Mario Cuello, Ernesto Gonzalez-Chavez, James Knapp, Pat Knipe, and Stuart Kramer.

OCPS Attendees: Dr. Barbara Jenkins, John Morris, Rick Collins, Woody Rodriguez, Laura Kelly, Jeff Hart, Joycelyn Henson, Regina Frazier-Thomas, Roberto Pacheco, Judith Padres, Toni Greene, Mayra Monge (as scribe).

Call to Order

A quorum was established and Vice-Chairman Merck, called the meeting to order at 8:12 a.m.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes from November 20, 2014 were presented and approved unanimously by the Committee.

M/WBE Subcommittee Report

Joycelyn Henson presented the "M/WBE and LDB report for the 2nd Quarter of FY 2015." She also informed the Committee of the outreach activities organized during the period from October 2014 to December 2014.

Mario Cuello asked if there are any private companies participating in the Disparity study. Joycelyn Henson responded that she will check on it and provide feedback to COVE members.

Finance Report

Rick Collins discussed the 2014 and 2015 Sales Tax Forecast (actual and projected) for the period from June 1, 2014 to May 31, 2015. Rick mentioned that the Sales Tax collection has increased by \$5M compared to the previous year collection during the same period. He also presented the OCPS Sales Tax Collection History from 2003 to 2014. COVE members requested a similar history on impact fee collection (from 2003 to 2014).



Judith Padres provided a quarterly report on the Sales Tax Referendum Projects and Expenditure/Commitment History to Date.

Mr. Gonzalez-Chavez requested for an analysis on Sales Tax to show the value of the architectural and construction awarded contracts by firm, for the same period of time.

Project Status

Regina Frazier-Thomas and Jeff Hart provided the January's status update for new/replacement and comprehensive projects.

Regina Frazier-Thomas presented a handout of the Project Status Summary Report for December 2014 and mentioned that the internal audit of the same report has yielded a smaller margin of error compared to the June's Audit report.

Jeff Hart provided a monthly status update for new/replacement and comprehensive projects. He informed the Committee about the projects under construction, substantially completed, anticipated future miles, projects in close-out, projects currently bidding and scheduled to commence construction later this fiscal year. He also provided a handout titled "2014 Lessons Learned (Work in Progress)".

Change Order Report

Roberto Pacheco reported that during the months of November and December 2014 there were no significant Change Orders or Amendments equal to, or exceeding \$200,000.

Furthermore, he outlined a list of RFQ's currently soliciting different services and provided a timeline for each RFQ. Roberto Pacheco also presented the quarterly report of Change Orders and Amendments for the period from July to September 2014.

CFO Report

Mr. Morris briefed the Committee on the Facilities Board Workshop presentation held on December 16, 2014. He gave a summary of the topics covered during the presentation.

Mr. Gonzalez-Chavez suggested a review of prototypical design options available to OCPS.



COVE members requested information about the benefits of building K8 schools. It was mentioned to COVE members that in a future meeting an OCPS K8 presentation outlining benefits of K8 schools will be presented.

Laura Kelly provided COVE members a copy of the draft resolution of the School Board of Orange County, Florida (School Board) and the Citizen's Construction Oversight and Value Engineering Committee (COVE) declaring its intent to proceed with the acceleration of certain construction projects and authorizing funding through internal borrowing against Capital Renewal Funds.

It was explained that the projects that are part of the acceleration program are: A) Group 2 Modular Elementary Schools, B) Functional Equity Middle Schools, C) Group 3 High Schools, and D) Future Relief Schools.

Mr. Collins explained the concept of borrowing money from Capital Renewal to fund the Acceleration program. He explained that OCPS would not jeopardize the Capital Renewal program and that the repayment will include both the principal and interest. The interest rate will be based on the Florida Prime rate investment pool. He also stated that a yearly report will be prepared and presented to COVE showing the borrowing and repayment amounts of the Capital Renewal funds.

It was agreed by COVE members to recommend the acceleration of the A) Group 2 Modular Elementary Schools and D) the Future Relief Schools.

COVE members requested to add to the resolution certain provisions outlining an annual review process, a minimum reserve requirement and repayment prioritization. COVE also requested OCPS staff bring back additional details on the repayment terms schedule.

Laura Kelly was tasked to re-write the resolution document and send it to COVE members by email for their review.

Adjournment

Mr. Pat Knipe requested to move the Annual Audit of Sales Tax and Capital Renewal Funds Committee report to the February's COVE meeting.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 11:10 a.m.
