COVE Meeting Minutes

The Construction Oversight and Value Engineering Committee (COVE) monthly meeting convened on Thursday, September 15, 2016 at 8:00 a.m., at Facilities Services, 6501 Magic Way, Bldg. 200, Orlando, Florida 32809.

Call to Order:

A quorum was established and Vice-Chairman Pat Knipe called the meeting to order at 8:04 a.m.

I. Approval of Minutes

The minutes from June 16, 2016 were presented and approved unanimously by the Committee.

II. <u>Presentation</u>

• Student Enrollment Projections

- Carol McGowin and Tom Moore provided an update on OCPS Student Enrollment Projections. The presentation included details on the methodology used to analyze growth of birthrates and migration.
- The birthrates, family demographics and enrollment counts for the entire District were graphically shown.
- Carol McGowin concluded that the data is collected year around and that adjustments are made annually to correct any anomalies effecting enrollment and budget planning projections.
- Dr. Jenkins highlighted the importance of this scientific methodology and the approach OCPS takes in our planning process and budget projections.

Community Update

 Lauren Roth provided an update about the progress she made revamping OCPS Facilities website. She informed COVE that currently she is working with ICTS to develop a new webpage for



Facilities, making it user friendly and easier to navigate.

III. <u>Departmental Reports</u>

Project Status – Regina Frazier-Thomas/Jeff Hart

• Regina Frazier-Thomas

 Monthly status update for new/replacement and comprehensive projects. There were no significant changes made to the report this month.

Jeff Hart

- There are currently 16 projects under construction amounting to approximately \$485 million.
- Three projects had CFI's (Clay Springs ES, Independence ES, and Eagle Creek ES) approved by the School Board on August 9, 2016 and one project had its CFI (Lovell ES) approved by the School Board on August 23, 2016.

• Comments/Questions

- Pat Knipe asked about "F7" being missing on Regina's report. She mentioned that it have gotten hidden after revisions to the report.
- Douglas Kelly asked about the Adopted Budget Change of \$21,450,000 in the Planning Phase of the report. Jeff Hart explained that the initial 2002 budget was based on the conditions assessment and as the project gets closer, the budget will be modified accordingly to reflect current conditions.
- Linda Lindsey announced that the Auditor General conducted an audit of the District Educational Facilities Planning and Construction activities and process and had no findings to report after completion.

 Update on the capital renewal projects, highlighting the budget and schedule for each of the 134 projects in either planning, design, construction or close-out amounting to \$164 million.

Comments/Questions

- Dr. Jenkins recapped on COVE's recommendation to the School Board of using \$200 million of Capital Renewal funds to accelerate some of the sales tax projects. Dr. Jenkins asked COVE to review and reevaluate their recommendations.
- Pat Knipe asked if anyone know what the operating budget is for Maintenance. Dale Kelly said District Wide Maintenance spent about \$30 million in the given budget year.

- The Committee unanimously voted to conduct a school bus tour in lieu of the October COVE meeting.
- There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:35 a.m.
