Site 204-AE-N-7 Orange Technical College - Apopka site

Design is complete for the Orange County Public Schools site at S. Central Ave. and W. 18th St. in Apopka. It is slated to become a satellite branch of Orange Technical College. The one-story building will be painted architectural concrete block with steel roof framing.

Site work includes parking with security lighting, fencing, new utility connections, landscaping and irrigation. The building will have space for a large learning lab, office for three staff members, work room, and restrooms. It will have the latest technology to support adult and technical training and meet sustainable building standards.

The building is designed to keep the neighborhood in mind during construction. The contractor will deliver materials only for immediate tasks to keep storage to a minimum. The project does not require large, noisy equipment or the long-term use of large cranes. Site utility installation will be coordinated with affected property owners.

Construction can occur during the hours of 6:00 AM to 7:00 PM on weekdays.
