

Construction to start on Dr. Phillips High

C.T. Hsu + Associates announced today that construction has begun on the Dr. Phillips High School campus renovation and expansion project for Orange County Public Schools.

CTH+A recently completed design services for OCPS to include a new 2-story classroom

building and a new visual and performing arts addition to the existing theater building. The addition will incorporate a black box theater and labs for dance, graphic arts, digital recording studios and music.

The campus will also undergo renovations to the administration

and gym buildings, as well as enhancements so that the onsite vehicular and pedestrian traffic pattern is safer.

The contractor for the project is James A. Cummings, Inc. Construction will be completed in phases, and the project is anticipated to be completed in 2015.
