

Elementary, Middle, High Schools, Special Centers, CTE and Charter Schools represent \$1.59B of the \$2.26B Operating Budget

Student Enrollment → FTE → WFTE → Allocations → Funding \$\$\$

Class Size Compliance

Class size compliance is mandatory

Elementary: Grades K-3 1:18

Grades 4-5 1:22

Middle: Grades 6-8 1:22

High: Grades 9-12 1:25


• Based on State Guidelines, all OCPS schools will be measured for class size compliance based upon school-wide <u>averages</u> for core classes within the applicable grade groupings (PK-3, 4-8, 9-12)
