Calendar Parameters


- State Requirements:
 - o 180 days in school year
 - Students may not begin prior to August 10
- Teacher Pre-Planning:
 - \circ 6 days prior to beginning of school year
 - o Prefer that first day for teachers is not on a Friday
 - Must be consecutive days immediately prior to students arriving
- Teacher Post Planning:
 - o 2 days immediately following last student day
 - o Prefer not to be split between 2 weeks (Friday & Monday)





Calendar Parameters

- **Professional Day:**
 - Non-attendance day for students and teachers
 - Must occur on a Friday in October
 - May not fall during FTE Week
- Presidents' Day:
 - **February**
 - o Non-paid, non work day
 - Student holiday



- Students/Staff must be in attendance
- Caution against having the Friday before FTE week off
- 2024-2025 October 7-11 February 3-7

Calendar Parameters

- Semesters:
 - 2 semesters in a school year
 - 90 days each, or as close as possible
 - First semester must end at Winter Break in December
- **Marking Periods:**
 - 4 marking periods each year; 2 in each semester
 - 45 days each, or as close as possible
 - Teacher workday between the first 3 marking periods
 - Separate marking periods may not occur within the same week
 - 2nd marking period must end at Winter Break in December
 - 3rd marking period must end at Spring Break

Calendar Parameters

- Winter Break:
 - o Must be 2 full weeks (Monday-Friday)
- Thanksgiving Break:
 - o Must include Thanksgiving Day and the day after (paid holidays for staff)
 - Has traditionally been the entire week of Thanksgiving (Monday-Friday)
- Spring Break:
 - Must be 1 full week (Monday-Friday)
 - Must fall between the 3rd and 4th marking periods

Calendar Parameters

- 10 Prioritized Bad Weather Days:
 - o Cannot include any paid holidays or Winter Break
 - Must be non-work, non-paid days for employees
 - Must occur as close to the weather event as possible
 - Historically, most tropical storms and hurricanes have occurred in August through October






Calendar Parameters

- Florida Statute XL VIII, Chapter 1011 requires:
 - 720 hours of instruction in K-3
 - o 900 hours of instruction in 4-12
- Beginning in 2023-2024, OCPS bell schedules exceed the required 720 hours in K-3 and 900 hours in 4-12
 - o Additional minutes added to the Middle School bell schedule
- Minutes above the state threshold equate to:
 - o 4 regular days and 1 Wednesday in K-3 and 4-5
 - \circ 3 regular days and 1 Wednesday in 6-12
- Up to 3 regular days and 1 Wednesday may be missed due to weather closures without students making up the days


