TITLE: Funding Proposals and Applications

POLICY:

- (1) The district shall seek and accept funds to increase the learning opportunities to supplement the basic curriculum and learning environment available for students. Sources of funds sought shall include the federal government, government agencies and/or private sources, foundations and donations to meet identified needs which cannot be met with district resources.
- (2) All new proposal ideas shall be submitted to the school board for final approval. All projects shall contribute to the attainment of adopted district goals and be compatible with district procedures. The superintendent shall direct that procedures be established for the processing of applications for all projects. All applications must follow the established procedures.
- (3) The school board shall retain the direction, supervision and control over all phases of any program. The proposed educational program shall not cause an excessive burden to the existing or any future budgets. Financing shall be provided either by district funds or project funds so that support will be maintained continuously for the duration of the project.
