TITLE: Campus Disorders

POLICY:

Individuals who enter school board property without a legitimate reason and create a disturbance or refuse to leave the property when asked by the principal or person in charge are subject to criminal penalty as provided in Florida Statutes.

- (1) The principal or designee shall direct an individual to leave the school campus or facility when the individual enters the campus and/or commits any act that interferes with school activities. Exceptions to this procedure are prescribed in Section 228.091, Florida Statutes.
- (2) The principal shall contact appropriate law enforcement officials in cases of disruptive activity or refusal to leave the school grounds and shall take appropriate action to have the offender punished as provided by law.
- (3) The superintendent shall be notified immediately of any such action.

TITLE: Security

POLICY:

- (1) Protection and Care of School Property

It is the duty of each school employee to safeguard and protect the properties of the school district. Employees shall take care to see that windows and doors are properly secured before they leave the school building at the close of the day. Students shall be instructed in the proper use of textbooks and supplies and in respect and regard for public property.
- (2) Burglary or Damage to School

Incidents of illegal entry, theft of school property, vandalism or damage to school property from other causes shall be reported by completing the Damage and Loss of Property (Prop 5) form provided by the Risk Management Department.
