TITLE: Flag Displays and State Motto

POLICY:

It shall be the policy of The School Board of Orange County, Florida, that:

- (1) The flag of the United States of America and the official flag of the State of Florida shall be raised above each school and at other appropriate places during all school sessions and on all legal school holidays, weather permitting.
- (2) Pursuant to Section 1000.06, Florida Statutes, the flag of the United States shall be displayed daily in each classroom of a public K-12 educational institution. The flag must be made in the United States, must be at least two (2) feet by three (3) feet, and must be properly displayed in accordance with Title 4 of the United States Code.
- (3) Pursuant to Section 256.041, Florida Statutes, the "All-American Flag Act," the flag of the United States of America and the official flag of the State of Florida, when purchased for public use on or after January 1, 2016, must be made in the United States from articles, materials, or supplies, all of which are grown, produced, and manufactured in the United States.
- (4) All school sites and ancillary facilities shall have the state motto as designated under Section 15.0301, displayed in a conspicuous place.
