TITLE: Individual Student Publications

POLICY:

Each high school principal may approve establishment of a school newspaper or magazine for students and their parents.

(1) The principal shall be responsible for supervising the publication of newspapers, magazines, yearbooks and programs and for ensuring that these publications do not impede or otherwise interfere with the educational purpose of the school. Publications shall conform with school board rules relating to communications with the public. The principal shall retain full editorial control over the style and content of all publications published by his/her school or over any publication which bears the imprimatur of his/her school

(2) The principal shall not allow advertising copy which promotes or contains references to alcohol, tobacco, or other electronic cigarette product, drugs, drug paraphernalia, weapons, or lewd, vulgar, obscene, pornographic or illegal materials or activities, gambling, violence, hatred, sexual conduct or sexually explicit material, movies rated stronger than PG- 13, gambling aids, or any other copy which is inconsistent with school objectives.

TITLE: Yearbooks

POLICY:

The principals of high schools and secondary special schools may enter into contracts or agreements for yearbooks on an annual basis. No contracts for a period of more than one year shall be approved. Elementary and middle school principals shall not enter into a contract for the publication of a yearbook.
