TITLE: Eye Protection Devices

POLICY:

The principal/director shall inform all teachers concerned with instruction in courses specified in Section 1006.063 and 1006.39, Florida Statutes, of the requirements relating to the wearing of eye protection devices. The principal/director shall direct such teachers to continuously follow provisions of Florida Statutes without exceptions.

- (1) The school district shall provide protective devices for employees, students and visitors when engaged in activities listed under the eye protection device law.
- (2) A student shall be required to wear the eye protection device as directed by the teacher when engaged in activities listed under the eye protection device law. A student's failure or refusal to wear the device shall be cause for suspension or dismissal from the course.

TITLE: Health Occupation Education Students

POLICY:

Instructions in the Universal Precautions, established by the Occupational Safety and Health Act and the Center for Disease Control, shall be furnished to all health occupations education students. All students shall diligently practice these precautions and employ them at all times when dealing with patients. Students who feel they have not mastered the use of these precautions before working with patients shall immediately inform the instructor of that fact so that additional guidance or review can be given.
