

STUDENT DISMISSAL PRECAUTIONS

TITLE: Granting Permission for Students to Leave School Grounds

POLICY:

No student shall be permitted to leave the school grounds during the school day without the principal's or designee's prior approval based upon a written request from the student's parent or legal guardian. If a student is requesting to leave the school grounds during the school day for school business/activities and written consent has not been obtained from the student's parent or legal guardian, the principal or designee shall contact the parent or legal guardian prior to releasing the student.

TITLE: Releasing A Student From School

POLICY:

- (1) The principal or designee shall establish the identity and authority of any individual who seeks the release of a student from school. A student shall be released only to a parent or legal guardian who has custody of the child or to an individual authorized to pick-up the student in the school registration documentation. If an individual other than the student's parent or legal guardian requests release of a student, the principal or designee shall obtain the parent's or legal guardian's consent prior to releasing the student.
- (2) A minor, married student may be released from school without parental/legal guardian consent.
- (3) A minor student who is a single custodial parent may be released from school when an emergency condition exists involving parental care of the child.
- (4) A minor who has been emancipated by the court may be released from school without parental/legal guardian consent.
- (5) A minor who is designated as an unaccompanied youth pursuant to the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act may be released from school without parental/legal guardian consent.
