In November 2010, Orange County voters approved a 1 mill property tax increase for four years to preserve academic programs, retain highly qualified teachers, and protect arts, athletics and student activities.


Here's how your 1 mill was spent in 2012-13:

★ Preserve academic programs and retain highly qualified teachers:	\$42,611,383
★ Protect arts (music, art, drama):	\$32,945,796
★ Protect athletics:	\$5,347,504
★ Protect student activities:	\$1,964,977
Total: \$82,869,660	

State funding

increased in 2013, but is not yet back to 2007 levels. Funding falls short when compared to inflation as shown by the CPI trend line. Thanks to your support and the 1 mill, we have been able to maintain a high level of service.
