




Your Vote Made A Big Difference

In November 2014, Orange County voters renewed a 1 mill property tax increase for four years to preserve academic programs, retain highly qualified teachers, and protect arts, athletics and student activities.

Thanks to your support, the students of Orange County are much better off than they would have been. You will see below that while regular state funding has increased slightly in recent years, it still falls short when compared to inflation. However, thanks to the additional 1 mill, we have been able to maintain a high level of service.

Budgeted funding per student



Here's how your 1 mill was spent in 2015-16:

Preserve	academic programs and retain highly qualified teachers (equates to 785 teachers, counselors, social workers, etc.) (includes career and college readiness programs)	\$50,999,690
Protect	arts (art, dance, drama, and music teachers)	\$41,874,117
Protect	athletics (pay for coaches and athletic trainers)	\$6,067,955
Protect	student activities (field trips and after school tutorials)	\$2,385,904
	charter schools proportionate share (not controlled by district)	\$6,901,387

Total: \$108,229,053
